Customs Duty

- Custom Duty will be applicable on final basis (non-refundable) in the absence of visible engraved serial number on each item and for consumables @ 5-12 % of CIF value depending on the commodity.

Customs Deposit

- Temporary import permission (subject to customs authority's discretion) will be applicable only if visible engraved serial number is on each item @ 5-12 % of CIF value will be applicable depending on the commodity.
- If shipment is granted temporary import permission, it may take 4-6 months to obtain refund of customs deposit / receipt after re-export.

Saudi Arabian Standards Organization (SASO)

Certain goods require SASO (Conformity) certificates before customs will allow them into the Kingdom. These goods include, but are not limited to the electrical items, Paints, Varnishes, Cars.

Hand Carry Exhibits

Do not hand carry exhibits into the Kingdom as it may delay the customs clearance formalities.

Insurance

It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to arrange Marine (Transport) Insurance covering transport to the exhibition, during the exhibition, and the return of the exhibits to domicile.

Information on Imports

The importation of alcohol/pigs in any form is strictly prohibited.

Saudi Customs have been known to confiscate literature to support the Saudi printing industry may require Ministry approval which can delay clearance by 2 to 3 weeks.

Should publications contain interviews with the Ruling Royal Family, they will have to be submitted for Ministry approval. This will delay clearance and will involve additional costs.

Do not send foodstuffs for hospitality purposes. Items such as tea, coffee, soft drinks, etc. can be purchased locally.

Certain goods are restricted for import into the Kingdom and are subject to approval which include Fertilizers ~ Chemicals ~ Seeds ~ Plants ~ Grains ~ Animal Feeds ~ Animals ~ Defense & Military Equipment ~ Communications Equipment ~ All Hazardous Cargo.

Saudi Arabia is a strict Islamic Country. Pictures of women working or with men ~ 3D representations of human or animal life forms ~ References to Islam ~ Pictures or references to Saudi Arabia, pigs, alcohol etc., are considered offensive.
